

2011 Community Table Policy and Registration Form

2011 Hours: Saturdays: 8am – 1 pm, May 1 – October 29 Tuesdays: 3:00 – 7:00 pm, June 7 – October 25

Participation Policy:

The Midtown Farmers Market invites not-for-profit community organizations to rent stall space at Saturday and Tuesday markets in order to share information about their work with the market community.

Scheduling: Groups that wish to table at the market must complete the Community Table Registration form and submit it to market staff (info@midtownfarmersmarket.org) at least eight days prior to the date(s) that they wish to attend the market. Groups that arrive on a market day without having been scheduled by market staff will be denied attendance at that particular market.

Fees: When the requested dates have been approved by market staff, the community group will receive an invoice for the agreed upon amount. The fee for each market is due the day before the market.

Saturday markets: \$25 per day
Tuesday markets: \$15 per day
10'x10' tent, table, and chairs rental: \$15 per day*

*Organizations are welcome to bring their own equipment OR can rent equipment from the market (when available).

At the market: Community table participants must follow these rules or will be asked to leave the market:

1. No products of any kind may be sold at the market site—all items available at a group's table must be available free of charge. Community groups may not pass out anything intended for consumption. Donation jars are permitted. If approved by market management, organization memberships may be sold at the market.
2. If participants plan to unload tabling materials directly from a vehicle, they must arrive before 7:45am on Saturdays and 2:45pm on Tuesdays. No vehicles are allowed to pass through the market after these times.
3. Information may only be distributed at designated tables. Participants may not approach or shout at shoppers passing by their tables. Participants may not stand at the entrance or walk around the market to distribute information.
4. All banners and signage visible to passers-by must not contain vulgar language.
